The Family Development Program provides support and education to families in the community who have been identified as recipients for intervention support due to various challenges that they encounter.

Approach

The program provides participants with access to resources that improve:

- Family relationships
- Parenting skills
- Communication skills
- Connection to community and natural supports
- Child development

With the program, over 85% of families have improved their overall child safety, over 80% have demonstrated an increase in their overall well-being and over 80% have increased their knowledge and access to community resources.
